Acoma is a bush French bean (snap bean) that makes medium-green, round pods with white seed. In the catalogue it's placed in the 12–13 sieve class, indicating fine, uniform pods suited to fresh-market grading. Expect the compact, self-supporting habit typical of bush beans and an even, concentrated set for efficient harvest.
